

Questions and Answers about the SCDP 2012 National Delegate Selection Process

When and where can I get the form to file to run for delegate?

The date filing for national delegate will open is not specified in the Delegate Selection Plan but persons have to be elected as a delegate or alternate to the state convention to be eligible to run for national delegate. The county conventions where the state delegates will be elected must be between March 15 and March 27, 2012. The filing period will start March 15, the first date that a county convention will be held, since that is when we will elect the state convention delegates so we know who is eligible to run for delegate. The filing forms will be on this website and all county chairs should have them available at the county conventions.

When is the deadline for filing the form to run for delegate?

The deadline for filing is April 12, 2012 at 5:00 pm. All forms must be received by regular mail or by fax by this date and time. Forms may **NOT** be sent by email.

Is there a cost to file to run for delegate?

No, there is no cost to file to run for delegate. However, you can chose to pay a \$50 filing fee to run for at-large alternate instead of obtaining signatures of 10 delegates to the state convention (See pages 8 and 15).

Who pays for the expenses for delegates to attend the national Convention?

Individual delegates are responsible paying for their own expenses as delegate. The SCDP
